Executive Summary

This deliverable provides details on the procedures and criteria that will be used to identify/recruit research participants in MOVING. In Section 1 the main directions for the recruitment of research participants are given. The recruitment of compliance officers among the staff of MOVING partner organization Ernst & Young (EY) is discussed in Section 2. In Section 3, details on the recruitment of young researchers, students and staff in MOVING partner organization Technische Universität Dresden (TUD) are presented. Section 4 similarly deals with the recruitment of young researchers, students, staff and external volunteers by MOVING partner Know-Center (KC). The recruitment methodologies for lab and remote studies that will be carried out by the University of Manchester (UMAN) are introduced in Section 5, and the deliverable closes with brief concluding remarks that are given in Section 6.
