Executive Summary

This deliverable presents the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) plan of the MOVING project. Specifically, Section 1 presents the history and the purpose of the deliverable, where we give a brief explanation in relation to the overall methodology used for generating the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) plan. Section 2 describes the IPR concepts and definitions by giving in detail: i) the definition of Intellectual Property (IP) and what forms it can take (e.g. Software, Know-how etc.), ii) the possible methods for protecting an IP asset, iii) the relation between IP protection methods and exploitation routes by briefly discussing how the different IP protection methods restrict, or do not restrict, the possible exploitation routes that we could take in MOVING, and iv) a summary of the IPR management provisions of the MOVING CA. Section 3 presents in detail the IP assets of the consortium partners (organised by WP) that they either have already generated within MOVING or anticipate to generate. Section 4 presents an analysis of the IP asset types and the IP protection methods that come out of the previous sub-sections of Section 3, analyses possible MOVING dependencies with external IP, and describes: i) the internal consortium procedures for protecting the project's IP assets, ii) the MOVING internal procedures for use or sharing of IPR between partners in MOVING, and iii) the procedures for handling joint IPR ownership in the project. Section 5 finally gives some brief concluding remarks.
